Attendance:

She has mandated protocols she needs to follow and the process will be more efficient by calling her directly. Don't forget to bring in a note the next day you're in school. Even when you're absent on a remote day.

Building Doors Opened

• Thank you for your assistance in having our building opened at 7:20. With our questionable Buffalo weather there will be a time when we will need to open the building for students before 7:20. We will look to open the doors on inclement days at 7:00 am. On those days students will need to enter through the front doors at the circle and report directly to the cafeteria. Students will be dismissed from the cafeteria at 7:20 and report to their first period class.
