Itinerary

THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 30

Depart Hamburg High School this morning for New York City. Meals/rest stops (individual's expense) will be coordinated between the teacher chaperones and the bus drivers. Upon arrival in New York City, you will go directly to Times Square where you will have time for shopping and sightseeing in small groups. During your free time you will also have dinner (individual's expense) before departing for your hotel to check in and remain for the evening.

FRIDAY, DECEMBER 1

BREAKFAST at the hotel. Board your chartered motorcoaches and depart to meet your guides in midtown Manhattan. You'll travel downtown where your first stop will be at the September 11 Memorial and Museum. This museum serves as the country's principal institution concerned with exploring 9/11's continuing significance. Following your visit at the museum, you'll have time for lunch (individual's expense) before visiting One World Observatory for a panoramic view of the city. After your visit to the Observatory you will head to the Chinatown/Little Italy area for dinner (individual's expense) and shopping. Following time for dinner and shopping you will travel to Rockefeller Center to see the world-famous Rockefeller Center Christmas Tree! Return to your hotel this evening and remain for the night.

SATURDAY, DECEMBER 2

BREAKFAST at the hotel. Board your chartered motorcoaches and depart the hotel for Midtown Manhattan. Meet your guides and visit Grand Central Station. Following your brief visit there, you'll have some time for shopping along Fifth Avenue and/or the Herald Square area. Lunch (individual's expense) as directed by your guides. After lunch you will continue touring including Central Park. This afternoon you will travel into midtown Manhattan where you'll visit Radio City Music Hall to attend the Rockettes' Christmas Spectacular show. Following the show, you'll have **DINNER** at Carmine's in Times Square, followed by some shopping time. Return to your hotel this evening and remain for the night.

SUNDAY, DECEMBER 3

BREAKFAST at the hotel. Check out and board your chartered motorcoaches and depart for Liberty State Park where you will board the first available ferry for Liberty Island for a close-up view of the Statue of Liberty. After some time at Liberty Island, return to Liberty State Park. Board your chartered motorcoaches and depart for Hamburg High School. Meal/rest stops (individual's expense) will be coordinated between the teacher chaperones and the bus drivers. Evening arrival back at Hamburg High School.

The program participant shall notify Travelogs International Inc., **NOT** the group leader, in writing of any cancellation. The amount of your refund will be determined by the postmark, fax, or email date of the written notice of cancellation. Any non-refundable payments made by Travelogs International Inc. for the group are always non-refundable to program participants. The cost of any non-refundable payment or activity is added to any stated administrative fees.
